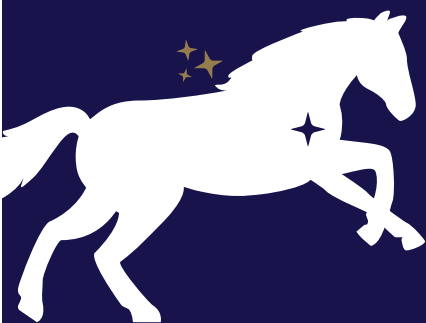

Suki's Story

From the moment we met her, we could tell Suki had endured more than most. As the eldest cat in a heartbreaking case involving 83 cats in a single home, 8-year-old Suki had long served as the matriarch of the group. She had given birth to countless litters over the years, her small body bearing the quiet burden of overbreeding and neglect.

When she arrived in our care, Suki had just delivered yet another litter of kittens. But it wasn't only her own babies she was nursing—when other mother cats in the home rejected their litters, Suki took them in too. She ended up with seven kittens of different ages, all desperate for her care.

Her body simply couldn't keep up. Even with around-the-clock bottle feeding from our team, Suki developed painful mastitis, likely caused by the babies trying desperately to nurse.

We stepped in quickly—administering antibiotics, providing pain relief, and ensuring the kittens received the nutrition they needed. When Suki was strong enough, she underwent spay surgery. What our veterinary team found was heartbreaking: one side of her uterus was so scarred and damaged that it could no longer support life—a clear sign of how many litters she had endured.

Thanks to your support, Suki is now safe, spayed, and recovering with love. She'll soon receive a much-needed dental, and then, at last, she can enjoy her golden years simply being adored.



Suki's story is a powerful reminder of why spaying and neutering is so vital. No animal should suffer the way she has. And because of you, she never will again.

Rocky's Story

When Rocky first arrived at BC SPCA Kamloops, he was a frightened stray with a painful, badly broken leg—an injury so severe that amputation was the only way forward. At just a year old, this Lab/Border Collie mix had already endured more hardship than most dogs should in a lifetime... but Rocky's spirit proved stronger than his injury.



With the help of our dedicated veterinary team and the support of generous donors like you, Rocky underwent surgery and began the long road to healing. Day by day, he showed us what resilience looks like—greeting staff with a wagging tail and soft eyes that held both gratitude and hope. His quiet strength and gentle nature captured every heart he met.

Now a happy, three-legged boy, Rocky doesn't dwell on what he's lost. Instead, he embraces every moment, leaning into love—literally. He's become known as our “Velcro dog,” always close, always seeking connection. He reminds us that healing is not just physical—it's emotional too, and made possible by compassion, care, and community.

Tonight, we honour Rocky's journey as a testament to what your support makes possible. Because of you, animals like Rocky get a second chance—a chance to heal, to trust again, and to rediscover joy.

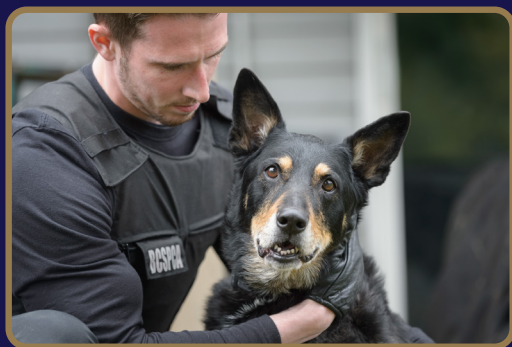
